



WMM80P06TS uses advanced power trench technology that has been especially tailored to minimize the on-state resistance and yet maintain superior switching performance.






Figure 1. Output Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. Forward Characteristics of Reverse




Figure 4. $R_{DS(ON)}$ vs. V_{GS}




Figure 5. $R_{DS(ON)}$ vs. I_D




Figure 6. Normalized $R_{DS(ON)}$ vs. Temperature




Figure 7. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 8. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 9. Power Dissipation




Figure 10. Safe Operating Area




Figure 11. Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance




Figure A. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure B. Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms





Figure C. Unclamped Inductive Switching Circuit & Waveforms


